Founded with Noel Bell in 1968 the firm Noel Bell, Ridley Smith later became Noel Bell Ridley Smith & Partners and is now NBRS+PARTNERS. The firm has received numerous awards and has a portfolio covering all building types with a particular expertise in education and civic projects, health, housing & churches.

Ridley was appointed University Planner and Architect for Southern Cross University in Lismore N.S.W. and has designed most of the new buildings on the relatively new campus. Since then Ridley has been in charge of many new projects on the University of Sydney Campus as well as retrofitting with latest I.T. some of the historically sensitive grand old sandstone buildings. Many Technical Colleges, Private Colleges and Schools and Government Schools form a part of the education portfolio.

Ridley has been on many world trips studying Educational Civic projects including a yearly trip to Ethiopia to the Fistula Hospital where he offers his expertise in the building and development of this facility.
